



3.08 – The Bible Principle – The Jubilee & Miracles.

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Introduction.

(Scriptures from KJV unless noted otherwise)

Foundation Scriptures:

Lev.25:8-17 - The Year of Jubilee.

Luke 4:18-19 - The acceptable year of the Lord.

1.0 - What are Miracles and what are they for?

3 places necessary:

- **Obedience in the Spirit** – bring your spirit into obedience to God
- **Obedience in the mind** – the bible says to bring every thought into obedience of Christ Jesus.
- **Obedience in your flesh.**
- Why do we not see more miracles amongst the Body of Christ – they *were never intended to take the place of the Word* of God – why? The just shall live by Faith!
- The main reason that we are not seeing more miracles is that we *do not know what they are for*.
- **Miracles start things anew** – so that old seeds can be wiped out or destroyed and new seeds can be planted and have time to grow –

Mark 4:26-28 - The Parable of the Growing Seed

26 And He said, "The kingdom of God is as if a man should scatter seed on the ground, 27 and should sleep by night and rise by day, and the seed should sprout and grow, he himself does not know how. 28 For the earth yields crops by itself: first the blade, then the head, after that the full grain in the head. 29 But when the grain ripens, immediately he puts in the sickle, because the harvest has come."

- Miracles are not to be lived on – we are to live on God's Word – by planting and harvesting on a continual basis.
- **Miracles are a bridge** over the gap between the time that it takes to destroy the old seeds out of the garden, replant and harvest that crop
- G. Stevens - personal experience during townhouse as God ploughed up my old field (heart) of worldly lies and deception and then sowed His seed of absolute truth.
- **Words are process starters**, or in other words **they are seeds!**
- The Law of Gradual Spiritual Growth governs all living things (Mark 4:26-29).
- God has set up these laws that even He must live by also.

The Law of Words.

- One of the things that every person must come to understand, learn and make it part of their lives and nature is that he or she has **no right to choose whether or not they live under words** – they have **only the right to choose** which words that they live under!

2.0 - Words are Process Starters.

Mark 4:14-30 (The sower sows the word.)

- Mark 4:17... affliction or persecution arise for the Words sake.
- Why? Words are process starters.
- You put seed in the ground, water it and give it light and there is no question the seed will grow – because it can't help but grow – a process began.
- Words are process starters of all life.
- V25 ... Satan takes away the word – because he has fear of the word and fear of you having the word and the word becoming rooted in you and then it will govern his activities.



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- V26 ... So is the kingdom of God (Jesus speaking!).
- V33 ... What was He using parables to teach?
- **The subject** ---- was the word of God
- **The object** ----- of the lesson was how to stand on God's Word, put it into your life and receive a hundred fold return.
- **The parables were about the KINGDOM!** – how to compare it by seeds.
- **Whatever** you want to know – plant it and it will grow!
- Seed, plant, harvest – the kingdom of heaven is compared as.
- What was the problem with the disciples? Jesus expanded the word in them but there had been no growing time of the seed and Satan stole the word from them by the storms (of life).
- **Everything is governed by the "Law of Gradual Spiritual Growth".**
- The growing time of the seed is not occasional, but always there.
- When you plant the seed it does not grow up before your eyes, it takes time!

3.0 - Story of the Watermelon.

Plant the seed / vine appears / small fruit appears / earthly father buys a large watermelon and puts it under the vine / normally this does not happen / we get to eat the large watermelon while we are waiting for our fruit to grow / we eat our melon and also have seed to replant again.

4.0 - Story of the Farmer and His Field.

He buys the seed / prepares the field with money and time / sows the seed / crop comes up but looks a little strange / the crop is a mixture of good and deadly poison weeds / did the ground argue to what seed will grow – no! The ground has no right to argue just to produce what is planted in it!

- **So what is he going to do?** The whole crop must be totally destroyed because any bad seed left in the ground will grow again next year.
- He must clean the field for a whole new crop and it takes time – seed, plant, harvest.
- He also has no crop to live off until his new crop grows next year.
- **What is he going to do?** – He needs a miracle!
- A miracle is to give him time to clean out that ground, kill that bad crop and have time to plant new seed.
- Next time he does not buy and old seed (not certified – world or religion) but he buys certified seed (incorruptible seed – **1Peter 1:23** *having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever,*).
- The seed is costly and is guaranteed and certified to produce what it says it will grow (and God watches over His word to perform it and Jesus is the surety of the word coming into manifestation!)
- **Where does he go now?**
- He goes to his Jubilee or the Jubilee principle!

Luke 4:18-21 (Isaiah 61:1-2)

18 "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the broken hearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed; 19 to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord." 20 Then He closed the book, and gave it back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all who were in the synagogue were fixed on Him. 21 And He began to say to them, "Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing."

- Jesus preached and said he was anointed and to preach the "Acceptable year of the Lord" – which is the Jubilee or the 50th year of Atonement.
- Jesus was saying **I am the Jubilee** – you do not have to wait till the 50th year.
- He was saying that you do not have to be sick anymore or poor anymore – that is why they became angry with him in the synagogue – who does he think that he is!



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- The Jubilee is on the day of atonement where people were set free from debt and more;

Lev.25:8-17 - The Year of Jubilee

8 "And you shall count seven sabbaths of years for yourself, seven times seven years; and the time of the seven sabbaths of years shall be to you forty- nine years. 9 Then you shall cause the trumpet of the Jubilee to sound on the tenth day of the seventh month; on the Day of Atonement you shall make the trumpet to sound throughout all your land. **10 And you shall consecrate the fiftieth year, and proclaim liberty throughout all the land to all its inhabitants. It shall be a Jubilee for you; and each of you shall return to his possession, and each of you shall return to his family.** 11 **That fiftieth year shall be a Jubilee to you; in it you shall neither sow nor reap what grows of its own accord, nor gather the grapes of your untended vine.** 12 **For it is the Jubilee; it shall be holy to you; you shall eat its produce from the field.** 13 "In this Year of Jubilee, each of you shall return to his possession. 14 And if you sell anything to your neighbour or buy from your neighbour's hand, you shall not oppress one another. 15 According to the number of years after the Jubilee you shall buy from your neighbour, and according to the number of years of crops he shall sell to you. 16 According to the multitude of years you shall increase its price, and according to the fewer number of years you shall diminish its price; for he sells to you according to the number of the years of the crops. 17 Therefore you shall not oppress one another, but you shall fear your God; for I am the Lord your God.

- Jesus did not tell them that He was the Son of God – He told them that the Jubilee has come – he was the Jubilee!
- **V11 – you are going to get a crop that you did not sow for – that's what a miracle is!**
- **A miracle is a process that God sows** for you because your old seed is bad!
- While you are getting rid of the old seed, He will give you seed to live on, to plant and eat and prosper on until your new crop of faith comes to be a harvest.

5.0 - Words are Seeds that Start the Processes of Life.

- 1st take heed to what you hear (Mark 4:24).
- Start listening to the words coming out of your mouth.

Luke 9:44 – Jesus said;

"Let these words sink down into your ears, for the Son of Man is about to be betrayed into the hands of men."

- Start to let Gods Word and **sayings sink down** into your spirit.
- You have to **dig up the old seeds** (kill the crop or harvest) **by repentance.**
- Start replanting Gods Word (seeds) and this is work, day in and day out.
- Jesus said "Take no thought Saying".

Matt.6:31 (KJV)

31 *Therefore take no thought, saying, what shall we eat? Or What shall we drink? Or Where withal shall we be clothed?*

- You can rebuke a thought by saying something other than that thought – take the Word of God and replace that wrong thought (Phil 4:8) – think on these things!

Phil.4:8 - Meditate on These Things

8 *Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things.*

- When you took that thought that came into your mind and said it, **a lightening process began.**
- By saying the thought, and it came out of your mouth, it went back into your physical ear then **down into your spiritual ear and into your spirit!**
- Faith comes by hearing and hearing (and hearing and hearing) by the Word of God – the Word of God must come out of your mouth!



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- Cast down all imaginations (thoughts) and bring them captive.

2 Cor.10:3-5

*5 casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, **bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ**, 6 and being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled.*

- Replace the thoughts with other thoughts by speaking!
- Jesus has been appointed the High Priest of our confession – to make it come into manifestation.

6.0 - What is the Method We use Now?

- Dig up the old seeds by repentance that we have produced a bad crop (manifestation).
- Start confessing what the Word says about the situation or circumstance – “Calling those things that be not as though they were”

Rom.4:17 (NKJV)

17 (As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, even God, who quickens the dead, and calls those things which be not as though they were.

Rom.4:17 (AMP)

*17 As it is written, I have made you the father of many nations. [He was appointed our father] in the sight of God in whom he believed, Who gives life to the dead **and speaks of the non-existent things that [He has foretold and promised] as if they [already] existed.***

- Cast down (throw down) all thoughts that are against Gods Word.
- Bring every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ Jesus.
- **Replace those thoughts with Godly thoughts by confessing them out your mouth** (take that thought saying).
- Thank God for the answer coming into manifestation.
- Thank Him for your Jubilee miracle that will get you past the time need for your new crop to grow and harvest.
- God will come in and sow and provide for you.

7.0 - God has a Jubilee for You!

- Regarding any area – including sickness in your body.
- Go back and correct as led by the Holy Spirit.
- The whole natural world is put into motion with and by the tongue –

James 3:1-6

*1 My brethren, let not many of you become teachers, knowing that we shall receive a stricter judgment. 2 For we all stumble in many things. If anyone does not stumble in word, he is a perfect man, able also to bridle the whole body. 3 Indeed, we put bits in horses' mouths that they may obey us, and we turn their whole body. 4 Look also at ships: although they are so large and are driven by fierce winds, they are turned by a very small rudder wherever the pilot desires. 5 Even so the tongue is a little member and boasts great things. See how great a forest a little fire kindles! 6 **And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity. The tongue is so set among our members that it defiles the whole body, and sets on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire by hell.***

- There is God and there is the Devil and one or the other has got your tongue, driving your ship, directing the natural events in your life and you are the deciding witness!
- Where your tongue is – that is the words you say and will be where your life is headed or going to!
